











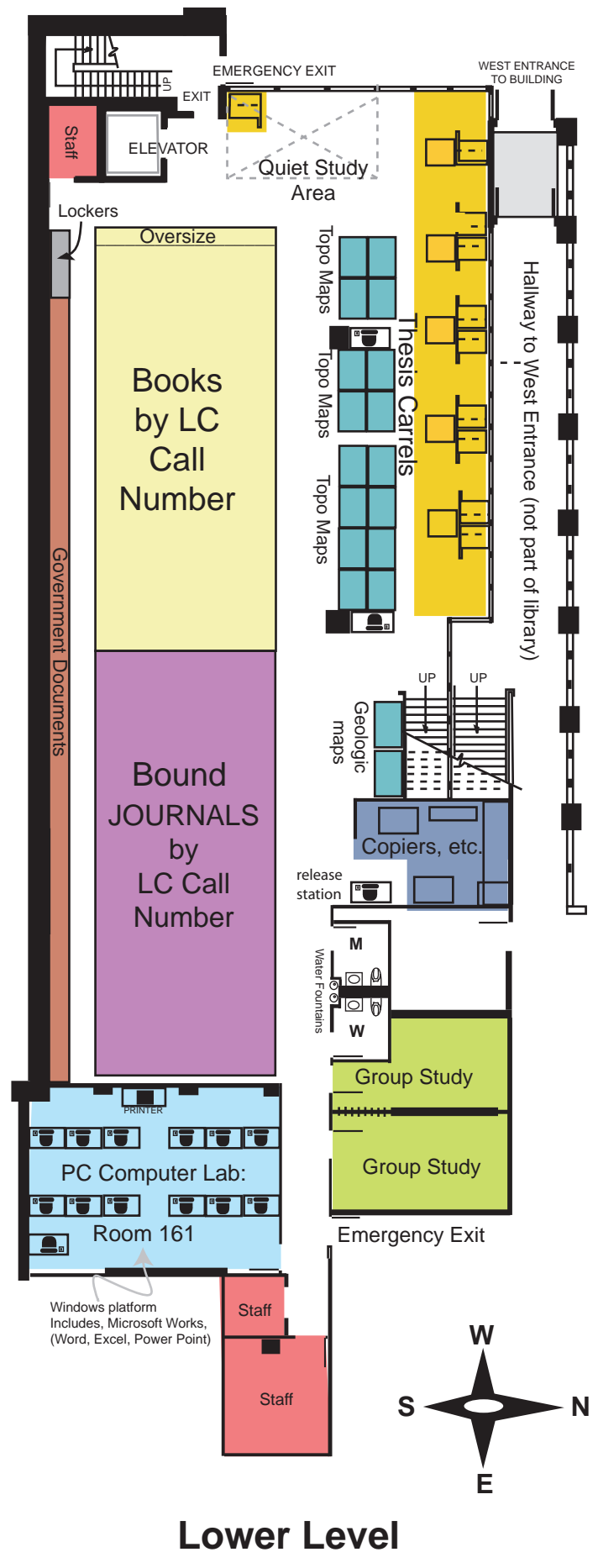


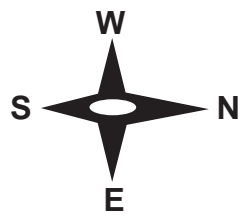
Entrance off Great Hall
