

How do I access archived Moodle courses?

Moodle sites are currently archived for two years. Teachers and students alike can access them as follows:

1. Go to the course index at <http://elearning.miis.edu/course/index.php> and select your course category, e.g. Language & Educational Linguistics.
2. At the top of the Moodle page, click on the **Archived Courses** sub-category.
3. On the archived courses page, click on the archived course you're looking for, e.g. Spring 2008. You will see an index of all archived courses in Spring 2008.

Step-by-Step:
