


How do I delete resources?

- 1. To delete a resource on the main page, just turn editing on, and use the X symbol.
- **2.** To see an index of all resources, click on the **Resources** index page in the top left-hand corner. It lists all uploaded **resources** (Word docs, etc) from your course, but no forums, no wikis, etc.
- **3.** The number to the left shows in which section of your Moodle course this link was originally created. If you go back to the main Moodle page, there it is and that's where you have to delete it from, using the X symbol.

Step-by-Step:

To delete a resource on the main page, just turn editing on, and use the X symbol.



To see an index of all resources, click on the **Resources** index page in the top left-hand corner. It lists all uploaded **resources** (Word docs, etc) from your course, but no forums, no wikis, etc.

Once you've deleted it from its original location, it should also disappear from the **index page** of all **resources.**

An alternative to deleting resources that you may want to use again is to **hide** them (click on the hide icon – an eye - next to an item or section) and **unhide** them later.
