1. Once you are on the Microsoft Office page, click **download** to acquire the compatibility software.
2. The download should redirect you to another page. If it does not, there is a link on the page that will tell you to click on it.
3. The Downloaded file easily unpacks with the Install Wizard.

For Mac Users:

For those of you who have a Mac and are getting DOCX files: Until Microsoft releases something, this website can be used to translate the docx files:

Upload the docx and your email and it will email you an HTML file you can copy and paste from. Also, you can request that the file creator saves the file as Word 97-2003 file.
